Therapies that can slow or halt progressive scarring are limited and although there is an increasing portfolio of pre-clinical research into the mechanisms and potential therapeutic targets for this condition there is still no effective anti-fibrotic medication available for treating patients with CKD. The UKRFN was established to identify barriers to the translation of pre-clinical work in this field and to promote collaborations to overcome them.
